Mask/Face Coverings:		Continue universal masking at both schools except during mask breaks/meals
Social Distancing:		At the elementary school, reduce to 3 feet as per CDC guidance while maintaining cohorts. Barriers available to all students
Mandatory Health Screenings:		Continue at both school entrances, temperature check required.
Contact Tracing:		Materials prepared in advance to improve response time, includes seating charts
Communication:		School Messenger via email and select targeting of voice mail for those without email
Testing:		Continue testing of asymptomatic persons on a weekly basis
Facilities:		No change
Cleaning and Disinfection		No change
Public use of Space:		No change
Student and Staff Pick Up and Drop Off:		No change
Small Spaces:		May be shared if individuals completed vaccination process
Child Nutrition:		Meals in either cafeteria or gym as space permits.
Social Emotional Well-Being:		Counselors conduct and/or arrange for counseling through Cayuga Counseling onsite services
Technology and Connectivity:		Purchased and deployed mifis Provide new devices to all UPK-2 nd grade students
Transportation:		Students will wear a mask <u>and</u> face shield on bus which will allow district to increase bus capacity
School Schedules:		No change

Vulnerable Populations:		Goal to increase participation of ELL students Increased daily participation of alternative placed and CTE students Increased contact/participation with at-risk SWD in Regents classes
Extra-curricular & Athletic Activities:		Resumption of adjusted sports seasons. Winter, Fall II, Spring
Emergency Drills:		No change
English Language learners (ELL) and Special Education:		Increased daily participation for Regents students Reaching out to families that selected remote option – goal to return all to in-person instruction
COVID-19 Coordinator:		No change

Attendance:		Daily attendance for full-time and remote students
