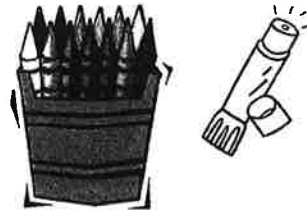


Dear Kindergarten Families,



Welcome to the exciting world of Kindergarten! We look forward to meeting you on Wednesday, September 6, 2017, for our Kindergarten Orientation Day. When you come to school for this exciting event, please bring with you the following supplies for your Kindergarten child's Classroom:

- 5 boxes of 24 Crayola crayons
- 6 Elmer's glue sticks
- Ziploc bags:
 - BOYS- 1 box GALLON size
 - GIRLS- 1 box SANDWICH size
- 1 large container of antibacterial wipes
- 1 package of #2 pencils



In kindergarten, we share all classroom supplies. Your contribution will be added to our "general" supply. We will request additional supplies, as necessary, throughout the year. There is no need to label any of these supplies (except folders).

Your student will need a beach towel for "quiet time". This towel should be labeled with your child's first and last name. They will also need a backpack. ALL supplies needed for the first day of school in September and replenished throughout the year.

ELA

- 1 - one subject (70 sheets) wide ruled spiral notebook
- 1 package loose-leaf paper

Math

- 1 - 1 subject spiral notebook-wide ruled

Supplies-Personal/Homeroom

- 1 pencil pouch or case or box
- 1 hand pencil sharpener (to fit in case/box)
- 1 box of crayons (24 or less) or 1 box of colored pencils (12 or less)
- 1 scissors
- 2 small glue sticks
- 1 package (2 per pack) of highlighters
- 3 packages (12 per pack) of pencils to start

Please have a backpack that fits inside your locker.

School supplies not kept in pencil pouch should be stored in the top of your locker for the school year.

ELA/Social Studies

- 1 HEAVY plastic storage envelope with string closure
- 1 ½ inch BLUE binder with 5 dividers
- 2 packs of 3"x3" Post it notes
- 4 packs of 1"x3" Post it notes

Supplies-Personal/Homeroom

- 1 pencil pouch
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 packages (12 per pack) of pencils – NO MECHANICAL PENCILS OR PENS
- 1 heavy duty folder or organizer for homework
